Role and Responsibilities:

- 1. The main aim of the Committee is to monitor the guidelines issued by the Ministry of HRD, UGC and by the Government of Odisha from time to time.
- The Committee ensures the effective implementation of the reservation policies as notified by the government for various programmes, accommodation in the hostels, appointments to the teaching and non-teaching posts.
- 3. Its function is also to help the SC/ST categories to integrate with the mainstream of the college community and to remove difficulties, which they may be experiencing.
- 4. To protect the rights of SC/ST students/staff/faculty members as given by the constitution of India in various provisions
- 5. To safe guard the interest of the SC/ST Faculty/staff/students, the committee members should be alert and vigilant
- 6. The committee should be take up issues of SC/ST Faculty/staff members regarding their timely promotion with welfare and put up to the higher authorities for necessary action
- 7. The committee should review the scholarship issues or any other financial assistants provided by the Central/state government from time to time
- 8. The committee should submit the monthly report regarding the problems/issues of concerned staff/students/faculty members regarding any matters which may hamper the self-esteem of the SC/ST students and staffs
- 9. The committee need to address the issues of the SC/ST students and employee and render them necessary help in solving their academic as well as administrative problems.
- 10. The committees need to plan for implementing various schemes of the AICTE/MHRD Government of India with the objective to improve the learning levels of SC/ST candidates bring them up.
